This award is the only Buffalo industry recognition of outstanding individuals.

Each person inducted into the Hall of Fame will be honored with a plaque displayed at the National Buffalo Museum located in Jamestown, North Dakota. A duplicate plaque is given to the inductee or their family.

The deadline to nominate someone is October 31st of each year. National Buffalo Foundation Board of Directors will evaluate each nomination.

- An active National Buffalo Foundation Board Member is ineligible for induction.
